- 3 tents (each within 20 ft (6m) of fire grate)
- 10 people (with maximum of 6 adults)
- 12-person gatherings (occupants + guests)
- 14-day consecutive stay up to 30 days/year

PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES

- Leaving campfire unattended
- Gathering firewood (purchase bundles from general store)
- Picnicking (use picnic areas)
- Altering / improving campsite
- Roller-blading & skate boarding
- Suspending items, e.g. hammocks

- Dispose of trash and recyclables at dumpsters and recycling bins
- Clean up pet excrement
